ORDER

Acting in accordance with La. Const. Art. V, §§1 and 5, and considering the emergency situation created by flooding in several parishes of the state,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

All filings which were or are due in this court between Friday, August 12, 2016 through Friday, September 9, 2016 shall be considered timely if received in this court no later than Monday, September 12, 2016. Parties who are unable to meet this deadline due to the flood emergency may submit motions for extensions of time, supported by appropriate documentation and argument.

Nothing in this order shall affect the briefing delays or scheduling of cases currently docketed for oral argument in September 2016. However, the parties in those matters may seek an extension or continuance upon a showing of hardship resulting from the flood emergency.
