



## 2010 Bench Bar Conference **Corporate Sponsor Opportunities**

Platinum Level - Any sponsor who contributes \$5,000 or more is designated as a Platinum Level Sponsor and will receive special billing in our publications both prior to and at the conference, the use of an exhibition booth and recognition for sponsoring various coffee breaks and/or social events at the conference. If you do not wish to exhibit at the conference, your platinum level contribution will enable you to be listed as a co-sponsor of one of the main social events or a combination of smaller events, and receive special recognition for your generous sponsorship.

Gold Level - Any sponsor who contributes \$2,500 to \$4,999 is designated as a Gold Level Sponsor, and will receive an exhibition booth and special recognition in publications both prior to and at the conference. An exhibitor is automatically a Gold Level Sponsor at the cost of \$2,500. If your organization does not want to exhibit, the \$2,500 contribution can be used to help underwrite a social event wherein your organization would get specific recognition. Depending on the amount contributed and the event you choose, you could be recognized as the sole sponsor.

Silver Level - Any sponsor who contributes \$1,000 to \$2,499 is designated as a Silver Level Sponsor and will receive special recognition in our publications both prior to and at the conference. The Silver Level Sponsor can underwrite a combination of events, including a coffee break (\$1000) and/or a hole at the golf tournament (\$500). Recognition of your sponsorship of the event chosen will be visible at that particular event and in the program materials.

Bronze Level - Any sponsor who contributes \$500 is designated as a Bronze Level Sponsor and will receive special recognition in conference publications both prior to and at the conference. A Bronze Level Sponsor can choose to underwrite a hole at the golf tournament (\$500) or the conference registration table. Recognition of your sponsorship of the event chosen will be visible at that particular event and in the program materials.
